Public Presentation Workshop of the EITI 2023 Report

Date: December 10, 2025, starting at 2:00 PM

The acting **Minister of Mines, Industry, and Technological Development**, Vice-president of EITI Committee, Professor **FUH Calistus Gentry**, will preside over the **Public Presentation Workshop of the EITI 2023 Report**, which will take place on **December 10, 2025**, at **Mont Fébé Hotel**, starting at **2:00 PM**.

This workshop marks a major step in the ongoing implementation of the **Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative (EITI)** in Cameroon. It provides a key platform for presenting the findings of the **EITI 2023 Report** for Cameroon, which highlights the state of transparency and management in the country's petroleum, gas, petroleum transport, and mining sectors.

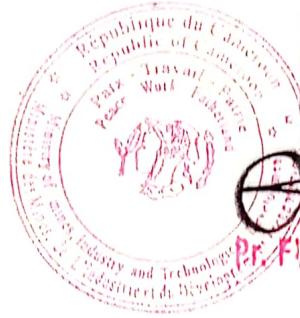
The objectives of this workshop are as follows:

- To present the results and conclusions of the EITI Report **regarding** transparency in the management of extractive resources for the fiscal year 2023;
- To share key recommendations for strengthening transparency and integrity within the extractive sector;
- To discuss actions to be taken to improve governance of natural resources and encourage the participation of civil society in this area.

The event will bring together key stakeholders from the extractive resources sector, including government officials, diplomatic mission representatives, development partners, EITI Committee members, focal points from the Permanent Secretariat, the Chamber of Accounts of the Supreme Court, various government entities, reconciliation entities, as well as civil society organizations and the media. Participants will have the opportunity to exchange views on the issues of transparency in the extractive industries and engage in enriching discussions aimed at strengthening governance in this strategic sector for the country's economy.

The medias are invited to cover this event and actively participate in promoting transparency of natural resources and public debate in Cameroon.
