Public presentation workshop on the report regarding the study on the integration of EITI data in Cameroon

Date: December 11, 2025, starting at 1:30 AM

Location: Mont Fébé Hotel, Yaoundé, Cameroon

The Acting Minister of Mines, Industry, and Technological Development, as well as Vice-President of the EITI Committee, Professor FUH Calistus Gentry, will chair the workshop for the presentation of the report on the study regarding the integration of EITI data in Cameroon. This workshop will take place on December 11, 2025, starting at 2:00 PM, at the Mont Fébé Hotel in Yaoundé.

This event is organized by the EITI Committee and aims to present the findings of a crucial study on the integration of the EITI standard into the government's information systems. The study was conducted by the renowned international firm ENERTEAM. It is part of Cameroon's ongoing efforts to strengthen stakeholder engagement and transparency in the traceability of revenues from natural resources, particularly in the petroleum, gas, and mining sectors.

The objectives of the workshop are as follows:

- To present the findings of the study on integrating the EITI standard into the government's information systems;
- To propose recommendations for strengthening the government's capacity for transparency, including improvements in the management and integration of data into public systems;
- To discuss the adoption of appropriate technologies for the collection, processing, and dissemination of information related to the extractive industries.

This event will bring together government officials, diplomatic missions, development partners, EITI Committee members, focal points from the Permanent Secretariat, the Supreme Court's Chamber of Accounts, various government entities, organizations involved in reconciliation, civil society organizations, and the media. Participants will have the opportunity to engage in discussions on how to enhance transparency through the increased use of information technology.

Journalists are invited to attend this event to receive detailed information on digital governance measures and their impact on transparency in the management of natural resources in Cameroon.
